OPEN MEETING

- Call to order by Mayor Hoopes at 7:04 p.m.
- Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor

Roll Call by City Clerk- In attendance is: Aaron Hansen, Tom Abbott, Brent Schindler, and Gloria Hoopes. Nanci Garling is absent.

Also in attendance is: Kelly Nead from Teton Valley Septic, Julia Tellman from Teton Valley News and Blaine Ball.

Action Items

Valley Septic LLC, Kelly Nead- Draft contract was revised and it was decided to add “blue water in accordance with DEQ regulations”. Contract was further reviewed and agreed upon. Schindler moves to renew the sewer lagoon use with Valley Septic/ Kelly Nead as proposed with the amendments of adding the DEQ regulations. Abbott seconds. Motion passed.

Conditional Use Permit- Blaine Ball consulted with the City Council about adding a fuel tank on his property for use of Teton County Road and Bridge. Hansen moves to approve the tank for use of the Teton County equipment. Schindler seconds. Motion passed.

Proposed Sanitation Ordinance 2019-02- Roll call vote to approve proposed sanitation ordinance 2019-02: Schindler-I, Hansen I, Abbott I, Hansen moves to suspend the rules and consider thrice read. Schindler seconds. Motion passes.

Regulations for hunting on City Property- A complaint was made to City Hall about hunting on the City owned Rodeo Grounds. City will be posting no hunting signs on rodeo grounds and will refer violators for hunting to game and fish. No motion needed.

Planning and Zoning recommendation- It was decided to table the recommendation for planning and zoning until next meeting. No motion needed.

Approval of election results- Schindler moves to accept the Teton County voting totals as presented by County Clerk spreadsheet, Hansen seconds. Motion Passed.

Approval of Emergency Drinking Water Systems Plan- To keep in compliance of USDA Loan, this plan has been set into place. Abbot Moves to approve emergency plan as presented, Schindler seconds. Motion Passed.

- November Public Hearing Minutes- Abbott moves to accept minutes being combined with November Special minutes as a continuation of Public Hearing. Hansen seconds. Schindler Abstains. Motion passes.
