Action Items

Idaho Transportation Department, Future of Hwy 33 Action- Jeff Sneddon from Idaho Transportation department presented to the City Council some of the upcoming concerns for roads including safety. He mentioned that a past idea that ITD had presented was the possibility of rumble strips. They would be installed 1 mile before the 32 junction outside of Tetonia, stop at the city limits and pick it up again outside of Driggs all the way to the WY line. He will be going to the ITD board to request the funds and hope to start construction in the spring of 2023. Another topic he discusses was the increase of traffic volume and increased safety concerns. He showed a traffic study from 2021 and talked about the average daily cars on the road and how it has increased significantly. He discussed some short and long term planning goals to help with highway safety and hopes to have a multi-agency planning group to help coordinate planning and safety. Questions were asked and clarified. No motion needed.

Snow Policy- Change parking ordinance to include winter parking time frames. OK to order signs. Will post and amend ordinance and policy to state winter. Move to update the snow policy with the winter additions. Ball seconds. Motion passed.

Park Winter Bathroom- Action

Bonilla moves to approve 1 porta potty rental for the winter months so that the bathrooms may be winterized. Green seconds. Motion passed.

Consent Agenda-Action

- November 2022 Claims- Green moves to approve the November 2022 claims as presented. Bonilla seconds. Motion passed.

Enforcements/ Compliance Updates- Action
