### **OPEN MEETING**

### **ACTION ITEMS**

#### **School/Church Road Update Project, Grants- Sunrise Engineering- Action**

Rob Heuseveldt reviewed a proposed plan of updating the block around the church and the school to make a safer traffic flow. Several funding options have been researched. Discussion was made about shovel ready plans scoring higher on grant applications. The Council was asked if Tetonia is interesting in moving forward with this proposed block update and if they are interested in applying with shovel ready, engineered plan, or if we want to try to apply for funding with more of a concept design.

Rasmussen moves to allow Tetonia to move forward with requesting a project cost breakdown pending a RFQ roster selection. Hansen seconds. Motion approved.

#### **Road Closure for Clean Up Project- Action**

Review of the TUP resolution was made and discussed that closing a road would need to follow the proper TUP process.

No motion made.

#### **Lawn Mower- Action**

The City mower was returned from a 6 week repair and lasted 30 minutes before it broke down again. Councilman Rasmussen offered her personal mower to try and get by for the summer. ITD offered their mower on a loan, but it is small and not ideal to mow 2 acres of grass. The loan of the smaller mower was accepted. Discussion of purchasing a new mower will be moved to the next fiscal year as needed.

Mayor Schindler presented a document of "Public Comment Rules" for council review. Mayor Schindler's intent for this list is to post the rules for meetings and on agendas and in other well seen areas of City Hall.
