Action Items

FY22 Audit Presentation – Action

COOP Plan adoption- Action

Review was made of the COOP plan (Continuity of Operations Plan) that is filed with Teton County. Hansen moves to approve the COOP plan for the City of Tetonia. Bonilla seconds. Motion Passed.

Emergency communication strategies were discussed. Current Tetonia uses the County Emergency Code Red system for alerts.
