Please keep a small stream of water running in your home. It will not affect your bill and may prevent high repair bills and hours of frustration. We have had two water main breaks in the last week. Remember that not all lines were replaced in our last project. In addition to that property owners' lines do freeze and back up to the meter. Frozen lines on private property are the responsibility of the owner. The frost is very deep right now and it makes it difficult, if not impossible, to thaw. One other winter warning is beware of reduced vision in our intersections due the volume of snow accumulated in cleaning the streets. Also remember that vehicles parked on Main Street should be within 18 inches of the curb. We have had complaints of vehicles parked in the traffic lanes.
