



OPEN MEETING

- Call to order by Mayor Schindler at 7:00 PM
- Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Brent Schindler.

Roll Call by City Clerk- In attendance is: Aaron Hansen, Blaine Ball, Cody Green, Ryan Bonilla and Brent Schindler.

PUBLIC HEARING: Budget Amendment Hearing for FY2022

Mayor opened up meeting for public comment session regarding FY 2022 budget amendment. No public comments were given.
Public comment period closed by Mayor.

Action Items

Adopt Budget Amendment Ordinance 2022-04 Action

Hansen moves to suspend the rules, read by title only and be considered thrice read. Bonilla seconds. Motion passed.

Hansen moves to approve ordinance 2022-04, Hansen reads title only with a clerical edit of changing name to City to Tetonia on first line. Green seconds. Motion passed.

Kelly Nead- Sewer Lagoon Contract- Action Kelly Nead approached the Council about resuming a previously contracted agreement to be able to unload his septic truck into the Tetonia sewer ponds. Kelly proposed raising his rates by up to %50 to be able to continue unloading. Kelly suggested his fee increase would help the City by softening the cost of dredging the ponds when that task is needed. Mayor Schindler updated the Council about the state of the sewer lagoons. We are currently operating under Jared Gunderson's, Tetonia back up operator, sewer license. Mayor Schindler explained that any decisions regarding the sewer lagoons need to be at Jared's approval while his is the only operator's license currently active. Kelly Nead's request to continue unloading at the Tetonia sewer lagoons was denied. No motion needed.

Water Supply Bank Lease- Action Hansen helped explain that a previous water supply agreement proposed by the Friends of the Teton River had suggested that City put their unused water rights into a water bank so that some people are still able to use the water while the City was not. Hansen suggested keeping the water rights in the water bank. Hansen moves to apply for a renewal the water bank lease, Green seconds. Motion passed.

Constitution Week Proclamation- Action Mayor Schindler read the proposed Constitution Week Proclamation. Ball moves to accept the presented Constitution Week Proclamation, Hansen seconds. Motion passed.

Past Due Enforcement Invoices- Action- Account in question was discussed. Attorney Birch will draft a letter explaining that past due invoices will be sent to collections. No motion needed.

Teton County All Hazard Mitigation Plan, Resolution 2022-03 Review was made of the Teton County All Hazard Mitigation Plan. Bonilla moves to accept Resolution 2022-03 as presented. Hansen seconds. Motion passed. Three aye's, Ball abstains.

ICCTFOA, Raffle Donation-Action Clerk Beard asked for up to \$100 to purchase prizes to donate to the District 6 raffle basket that helps to raise money for scholarships at the Idaho City Clerks Treasurer Finance Officers Association. Ball moves to approve up to \$100 to the ICCTFOA. Green seconds. Motion passed.

Park Update, Electrical quote- Action Council discussed the pros of having updated power boxes, breakers and outlets in the City Park. Green moves to approve the park electrical quote up to \$9000. Ball seconds. Motion passed.
