TITLE 5 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

CHAPTER 1

PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS

5-1-1: PARKING

Every person operating a motor vehicle, when parking the same must do so in accordance with the posted parking signs erected; and or within the defined and designated yellow lines laid out along the Main Street, and one block east and one block west of Main Street, of the intersecting street to-wit: Center Street, Teton Street, Jackson Street, Perry Street and Leigh Street.

5-1-2: PEDESTRIAN LANE AND SIDEWALK

It shall be unlawful for one to park a motor vehicle on any posted or defined pedestrian's lane, and to park a vehicle on the sidewalk anywhere within the confines of the City of Tetonia, Idaho.

5-1-3: DEAD STORAGE

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicles or place any farm machinery or other equipment in one place within these prescribed areas and to allow same to remain for more than eight hours; which shall be considered "dead storage."

5-1-4: PENALTY

The violation of any one of the above prohibitions shall constitute a violation of this ordinance and upon conviction the offender shall be fined not to exceed \$100.00 for any one offense. Violators may be towed. (Ord. 11, 1968; Ord. 2008-2)

5-2-1: INTENT

It is hereby declared to be the intent of the governing body of the City of Teton, Idaho, to aid and assist by whatever means possible, for the utmost consistency in traffic regulation among and between agencies of Idaho having such jurisdiction. Toward that end, adoption of the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws by the Cities of Idaho is a necessary means of assuring maximum uniformity within the state.

5-2-2 : ADOPTION OF LAWS

There is hereby adopted for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the use of all streets and public thoroughfares of the City of Teton, Idaho, that certain code, identified as the 1969 revised edition, Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, more particularly title 49, Idaho Code, published by the Department of Law Enforcement, and as the same may hereafter be revised by the Idaho legislature, or amended by the governing body, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the city as though set forth at length herein.

5-2-3 : COPY OF LAWS

Three copies of the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, together with any revisions or amendments, duly certified by the city clerk, shall be kept on file in the clerk's office for use and examination of and by the public. (Ord. 36, 11-5-1984; Ord. 2008-2)

CHAPTER 3

5-3-1 : UNLAWFUL USE OF ENGINE BRAKES AND COMPRESSION BRAKES

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to use or operate or cause to be used or operated within the corporate city limits of the City of Teton, any engine brake, compression brake or mechanical exhaust device designed to aid in the braking or deceleration of any vehicle that results in excessive, loud, unusual, or explosive noise from such vehicle.

5-3-2 : FINE

The scheduled fine for a violation of this chapter shall be fifty (\$50) dollars.
