CHAPTER 1

PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS

5-2-1: PARKING

Every person operating a motor vehicle, when parking the same must do so in accordance with the posted parking signs erected; and or within the defined and designated striped lines laid out along the Main Street, and one block east and one block west of Main Street, of the intersecting street to-wit: Center Street, Teton Street, Jackson Street, Perry Street and Leigh Street.

5-2-2: PEDESTRIAN LANE AND SIDEWALK

It shall be unlawful for one to park a motor vehicle on any posted or defined pedestrian's lane, and to park a vehicle on the sidewalk anywhere within the confines of the City of Tetonia, Idaho.

5-2-3: DEAD STORAGE

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicles or place any farm machinery or other equipment in one place within these prescribed areas described above in Section 5-1-1 and to allow same to remain for more than eight hours; which shall be considered "dead storage."

5-2-4: PARKING OF VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS

- A. No person shall park the following, whether attended or unattended, upon the streets in any residential area within city limits for a period in excess of two (2) hours:
1. Any vehicle, either motorized or unmotorized, having a gross weight capacity in excess of twelve thousand (12,000) pounds, or
 2. Any trailer or mobile home regardless of type, or
 3. Any vehicle designed or used primarily as farm equipment, or
 4. Any recreational vehicle:
 - a. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this section, motor homes, travel trailers and camp trailers may be parked on the street for a period not to exceed seventy two (72) hours;
 - b. The seventy two (72) hour period applies irrespective of whether they are attached to a motorized vehicle.

- B. No person shall park any vehicle upon the streets in any residential area within city limits for a continuous period in excess of seven (7) days.

5-2-5: SNOW REMOVAL

- A. Seasonal Parking Restrictions: No person shall stand, stop or park a motor vehicle, trailer or other vehicle on any roadways or within existing public easements for such roadways, within the corporate limits between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. between November 1 and April 15 of any year.
- B. Snow Storage: It shall be unlawful to store snow in any city roadway or right-of-way or push snow across a city roadway in such a manner that snow remains stored in the roadway. (Ord. 2023-1; 04-19-2023)

5-2-6: PENALTY

The violation of any one of the above prohibitions shall constitute a violation of this ordinance and upon conviction the offender shall be fined not to exceed \$100.00 for any one offense. Violators may be towed. (Ord. 11, 1968; Ord. 2008-2)

5-2-1: INTENT

It is hereby declared to be the intent of the governing body of the City of Teton, Idaho, to aid and assist by whatever means possible, for the utmost consistency in traffic regulation among and between agencies of Idaho having such jurisdiction. Toward that end, adoption of the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws by the Cities of Idaho is a necessary means of assuring maximum uniformity within the state.

5-2-2: ADOPTION OF LAWS

There is hereby adopted for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the use of all streets and public thoroughfares of the City of Teton, Idaho, that certain code, identified as the 1969 revised edition, Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, more particularly title 49, Idaho Code, published by the Department of Law Enforcement, and as the same may hereafter be revised by the Idaho legislature, or amended by the governing body, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the city as though set forth at length herein.

5-2-3: COPY OF LAWS

Three copies of the Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, together with any revisions or amendments, duly certified by the city clerk, shall be kept on file in the clerk's office for use and examination of and by the public. (Ord. 36, 11-5-1984; Ord. 2008-2)

CHAPTER 3

ENGINE BRAKES

5-3-1: UNLAWFUL USE OF ENGINE BRAKES AND COMPRESSION BRAKES

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to use or operate or cause to be used or operated within the corporate city limits of the City of Teton, any engine brake, compression brake or mechanical exhaust device designed to aid in the braking or deceleration of any vehicle that results in excessive, loud, unusual, or explosive noise from such vehicle.

5-3-2: FINE

The scheduled fine for a violation of this chapter shall be fifty (\$50) dollars. (Ord. 2006-2, 9-14-2006; Ord. 2008-2)
